



Selecting "Find A Park" will take you to the same CASAS "Search for Mobilehome/RV Parks" webpage. Once there, you can search for all the mobilehome/RV parks in Sonoma County by selecting different criteria. When you complete a search, the list will show you:

- 1. Park name/park identifier/park address/phone number/location map link
- 2. Fire authority and Jurisdiction
- 3. Number of mobilehome spaces
- 4. Number of RV lots with (and without) drains
- 5. Name and address of park operator

## SCMOA PARK LIST DATA SOURCE

There are two sets of data of interest to SCMOA. The first set of data is found by setting the search criteria for **Park Status** to "Active" and **County** to "SONOMA" to produce the current open active mobilehome/RV parks in Sonoma County, sorted by the **Park Identifier** (49-nnnnn-MP). Only the first 100 are listed. To view the rest, you must scroll to the bottom of the webpage to select the next page. At the bottom of the webpage, you'll also see the total number of records and the options for downloading the data in Excel, PDF and CSV formats.



The second set of data is found by setting the search criteria for **Park Status** to "Closed" and **County** to "SONOMA" to produce the closed mobilehome/RV parks in Sonoma County, sorted by the Park Identifier (49-nnnnn-MP).

The MHP data that SCMOA downloaded needed further work to break out fields for better sorting options. SCMOA imported the data into a Micro Soft Access database in order to better relate to other data that SCMOA collects, e.g. park resident contacts.
